# **General Guidelines**

The Final Results of CET-2022 have been declared in FOUR different lists as under:

- List 1 Results of All Graduate Candidates (GS, CET & Interview Marks)
- List 2 Result of All Undergraduate Candidates (GS & CSAT)
- List 3 Results of Candidates Shortlisted for Interview (GS + Interview) (Overall Merit-wise)
- List 4 Results of Candidates Shortlisted for Interview (GS + Interview) (Category-wise Merit)

# **Selection of Training Centres**

(1) All qualified candidates listed in the List 3 and 4 above have to select centres in the descending order of their preferences by numbering them as 1 for the most preferred and 11 for the least preferred centre.

Candidates are advised to select the maximum number of centres as per their combined score of GS and Interview, eligibility and intake capacity.

Note: If the intake capacity of the institutions is not exhausted from the List 3 and 4 above then the candidates from the List 1 will be considered on the basis of their scores in GS Paper in Round - 2.

- (2) The candidates can select Training Institutions in the descending order of their preferences by logging in to their Admission Dashboard, using their log-in ID (Application No.) and Password or Mobile No.
- (3) <u>Centre Selection option has been activated only for those candidates who have qualified for the interview (Refer to List No. 3 and 4 for Eligible Candidates).</u>
- (4) The candidates should exercise due diligence while selecting Training Centres. Training Centre once cannot be changed under any circumstances.
- (5) The Admission Portal will be operational as per the following schedule:
  - Date and Time of Opening of Admission Portal 28<sup>th</sup> December, 2022 from 10.00 a.m.
  - Date and Time of Closing of Admission Portal
     30<sup>th</sup> December, 2022 till 12.00 mid night.
- (6) The candidates who fail to select centres during the above time frame will not be considered for admission to any Training Centre under any circumstances.

- (8) Training Centres do not take any responsibility, if any qualified candidate fails to select preferred Training Centre as per the above schedule for any reason of whatsoever nature.

#### **Admission Process**

- (1) The admissions will be granted to students on the basis of their performance in CET and interview, admissions guidelines of respective training centre and its intake capacity.
- (2) Students should check SIAC website (<u>www.siac.org.in</u>) for the admission list to be displayed post selection of the Training Centres.
- (3) Admissions will be administered through online mode. However, a physical copy of application along with self-attested photocopies of attachments must be submitted at the time of admission in hostel.
- (4) In respect of admissions, the decisions of the Admission Committee consisting of representatives from SIAC, PITCs, YASHADA, BARTI and PCMC will be final and binding.

## **Educational Qualifications:**

The candidate should be 'Graduate' from any stream from any recognised university.

# **Age Limit:**

As on 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2023:

(a) Open Category - 21 to 32 years.
 (b) OBC/VJ-A/NT-B/NT-C/NT-D/EWS - 21 to 35 years.
 (c) SC/ST - 21 to 37 years.
 (d) Divyangjan - 21 to 45 years.

#### **Domicile:**

The candidate should be domicile of Maharashtra. Candidate domiciles of Maharashtra-Karnatak Disputed (MKB) Border Region should fulfil the following conditions:

- (a) Should have cleared the qualifying examinations from the institution located in Maharashtra-Karnatak Disputed Border Region.
- (b) Should produce a certificate from the Head of the institution that his/her mother tongue is Marathi and had Marathi Language as one of the subjects at SSC Exam.
- (c) Should produce a letter from the concerned District Collector that his/her parents are the domicile of Maharashtra-Karnatak Disputed region.
